Dewey Elementary School is extremely proud of our students' performance on the 2007 ISAT assessment. 89.7% of our students met or exceeded expectations in reading, and 100% met or exceeded in math. In our continued quest to increase student performance we have established the following goals for the 2007-2008 school year:

**GOAL #1**Improve reading performance

- a. 70% of all kindergarten students will read at least a level D using the DRA
- b. improve reading on the DRA test to 70% of first grade students reading independently at DRA level 16 or above
- c. improve functional reading on the Stanford by increasing scores for our average and above average 2<sup>nd</sup> grade subgroups by 10% overall
- d. 75% of all third grade students will meet or exceed in reading using the ISAT

**GOAL #2**Improve writing performance

- a. pilot the Lucy Calkins Writing Model in all grade levels to be assessed by the Linda Dorn writing rubric
- b. continue the implementation of Writer's Workshop for those not piloting Lucy Calkins that will be assessed by the Linda Dorn writing rubric

**GOAL #3**Improve math performance

- a. 70% of all kindergarten students will be able to count to 100 independently by verbal expression
- b. improve math performance by implementing pre and post testing to help track quarterly progress, for 1<sup>st</sup> grade students, using Chicago Math unit test
- c. improve measurement scores in 2nd grade by increasing our average and above average subgroups on the Stanford by 10% overall
- d. 85% of third grade students will improve the use of problem solving strategies on the ISAT

**GOAL #4**Improve attendance

- a. achieve a 97% attendance rate for this school year

**GOAL #5**Develop and maintain partnerships

- a. continue partnership with Quincy University

**GOAL #6**Develop and maintain school environment/climate

- a. continue the implementation of Stephen Covey's "7 habits of Highly Effective People"
