UPDATE

WELCOME BACK!

At last night's Board meeting, Superintendent Lemon reported on the first day back to school for students. He visited several buildings and found enthusiastic staff and students ready to begin the year. He thanked teachers and support staff for their efforts to get school off to a great start. The Board also commended Maintenance Director Dennis Peters and custodial and maintenance staff for their hard work this summer. In addition to regular summer cleaning and repair, his staff had numerous projects to complete. Closing Irving School and moving the Alternative Program required many hours. Superintendent Lemon said Quincy's school buildings are well kept and very clean compared to others districts where he has worked. Thank you to Dennis and custodial/maintenance staff. 2008-2009 TENTATIVE BUDGET

The Board approved the 2008-2009 Tentative Budget. Tentative revenue is \$66,205,830 and expenditures are \$70,262,158. The projected -\$4,056,328 deficit will be offset by the \$5,414,871 surplus in last year's budget. Business Manager Rich Royalty explained that the surplus last year is due to the district receiving funds for Life Safety Projects but the expense for those projects will be paid out of the 2008-2009 budget. The final budget will be adopted at a special meeting to be held Friday, September 26, 7:00 a.m. at the Board of Education Building.
