ITEMS OF INTEREST:

- **A REMINDER TO ALL STUDENTS**—Electronic devices and cell phones must be off and out of sight from the first bell in the morning to the last bell at 2:25 p.m. If a staff member sees a phone or electronic device during this time it will be taken. Don't put yourself in a situation where you will be banned from having a phone or electronic device.
- **FINAL EXAM SCHEDULE**—Students are required to be in attendance on exam days for those periods unless a parent calls in to excuse the student. Students are to remain in the classroom for the entire exam time period. Lunch will be available to students and staff each day as listed. Senior students who met/exceeded on the '08 Spring PSAE in Reading and Math are exempt from the three days of exams. Students in this category would have received a certificate earlier this year. During final exams, busses will run their REGULAR morning and afternoon schedule. Students who leave after exams may choose to make other transportation arrangements on that Thursday, Friday and Tuesday. Teachers are available in the afternoon for individual help for makeup.

It is important that we organize the graduation program so it will take place with precision and formality. In case of rain, practice will be held Friday, May 29 at 10:00 a.m.

- **BACCALAUREATE SERVICE**—Graduating seniors and juniors are invited to participate in this service on Thursday, May 28 at 7:00 p.m. conducted by the Quincy Ministerial Association.
