- **SPRING BLOOD DRIVE:** On Friday, May 7, 2010, the American Red Cross will conduct a blood drive in the QHS Gym (west side) from 7:45am-1:45pm. We are encouraging students, faculty, and staff to donate blood to this worthwhile cause. QHS has set a goal of collecting 82 unites (pints) of blood. All potential donors are encouraged to eat breakfast and/or lunch before donating blood. The Red Cross personnel also recommend that each donor take a multivitamin with a nutritious meal the evening before blood donation. Another multivitamin should be taken with a breakfast high in iron the morning of blood donation. Each student MUST bring a driver's license or another form of ID that states the student's birth date and social security number. Please note: Persons who have a tattoo or non-sterile body piercing are to refrain from donating blood from 12 months after the procedure(s) was completed. A Red Cross volunteer will come to get you in your class on Friday, May 7, 2010 when it is time for you to donate!!! Please do not come to the blood drive until the volunteer comes to get you!!!
